Dear Parents/Guardians,

We will begin our Summer Program Tuesday, May 30. Most of our programming will run from 8AM-12NOON Monday –Friday, with the exception of our Boys Weights and Conditioning Program, which will start at 7AM-9AM. Summer Program will meet Monday- Friday through the end of June, with the exception of Boys and Girls Weights and Conditioning, which will run through end of July. Broadcasting, depending on student interest, may run through July also.

We have partnered with the United School District Transportation Department again for this summer and will provide FREE transportation to and from designated locations in our district. The North Bus will leave North Campus (Alexis) just before 7:30AM, arriving at Cameron Post Office around 7:50AM. The West Bus will pick up in Little York Post Office at 7:15AM, swing back by United JH lot at 7:25AM, and then Kirkwood Post Office at 7:30AM before heading this way. Times and routes may be adjusted as we figure things out the first few days.

We will again be offering both Academic and Enrichment opportunities this summer for our students. Our Academic opportunities are intended to “catch our students up” and/or “jump start” them for High School. Our Enrichment opportunities are intended to provide some fun for our student’s minds as well as their bodies, while learning.

We are providing opportunities for Math, English, Science, Art, Broadcasting, Crafts, and Recreation. We may enjoy a couple of College Campus visits, Field Trips, or a morning trip to a local park/pool. Student interest and participation will determine some of our daily activities.
